RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, in 2021 the City of Sun Prairie Neighborhood Navigators program was written into a federal COVID-19 response grant application submitted by the Wisconsin Department of Health Services; and

WHEREAS, the grant application was successful and the City of Sun Prairie is currently in year two of the three year grant; and

WHEREAS, the grant is funding a Neighborhood Navigators Program Manager position and is supporting the work of an ARPA funded 0.625 FTE Community Health Worker position; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin DHS grant administrators have proposed to increase the Community Health Worker position to 1.0 FTE to further support the needs of the community; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin DHS will pay for the full cost associated with increasing the position to 1.0 FTE through August 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the following budget amendment is required:
